


HEALTH CONCERNS

- SALMONELLA
 - 8 multi-state outbreaks of salmonellosis
 - States: 45
 - Case Count: 611
 - 32% were children under 5 years of age
 - Hospitalizations: 138
 - Deaths: 1



INFECTIONS

SOURCE OF OUTBREAKS

- Epidemiologic, trace back and laboratory findings have linked the outbreaks to contact with live poultry
 - From multiple hatcheries
- Regardless of where they are purchased, ALL live poultry can carry Salmonella bacteria, even if they look healthy and clean



SYMPTOMS

- Symptoms occur within 12-72 hours
 - Diarrhea
 - Fever
 - Abdominal cramps
- Lasts 4-7 days
- Most recover without treatment
 - BUT Severe diarrhea may result in bacteria getting to blood stream



PREVENTION

- Wash hands with soap and water after touching
 - Live poultry
 - Anything in the area where poultry live
 - Handling clothes and shoes that have touched live poultry
- Adults should supervise hand washing for young children



PREVENTION

- Do NOT let live poultry inside the house, in bathrooms or in areas where food or drink is prepared, stored or served
- Do NOT eat or drink in the area where the birds live or roam
