COME RIDE WITH ME CLINIC

Lincoln, Neb.-December 2, 2019 - The University of Nebraska–Lincoln Extension is pleased to announce its second Come Ride With Me Clinic, Feb. 15, 2020, at UNL Animal Science Complex on East Campus.

“For several years, we have had requests for clinics where individuals can bring their own horse and ride with an instructor,” Kathy Anderson, UNL Extension Horse Specialist, said. “This is a great opportunity where riders can get one-on-one instructions from two excellent instructors and judges.”

Anderson along with UNL Equestrian Team Coach Lori Jaixen will present and are accomplished in working with both horse and rider.

Jaixen coaches the highly successful University of Nebraska Equestrian Team and has had several ISHA high point riders and national champions. Jaixen certainly knows how to teach riders of all levels to enhance their horsemanship abilities.

Anderson has not only taught horsemanship to numerous students, but is an accomplished judge for several associations. She will provide valuable insight into how judges evaluate riders.

The two-part clinic on horsemanship is open to both youth and adults. The morning session runs from 9 a.m. – noon and focuses on bodywork and the afternoon session runs from 1:00 – 3:30

p.m. and focuses on pattern work. You must bring your own horse to learn on or if you do not have a horse, you may come audit the clinic for \$10 per person for the day.

The cost per session is \$50 or \$90 for the two sessions. Space is limited to eight riders per session, so register early at <http://go.unl.edu/pe8y>.
