C. Scholarship

- Applicants must have a GPA of 3.0 to be eligible for consideration
- Transcript must be submitted with application

D. Resume (15%)

- One page maximum

E. One Letter of Recommendation (15%)

- In sealed and signed envelope
- Should list applicant's attributes and how they will be beneficial to the Agriculture Industry in the future.
